DAY 01: ARRIVE IN ROME AND VATICAN CITY TOUR

On arrival at Leonardo da Vinci International Airport, you will be met by our local representative in Italy for a brief meet and greet. Later, proceed to your city centre hotel in Rome for check-in.

The capital of the Great Roman Empire and home to the Roman Catholic Church, Rome has been at the centre of European politics and Christianity since antiquity. After the fall of the Roman empire due to corruption and overindulgence, the city eventually fell into despair and ruin until the city's rebirth as a centre for awe-inspiring art and culture, and delicious cuisine. Today, Rome is one of the most visited city in the world, where tourists come from all over the world to explore its history and culture and fell in love with this 'eternal city'.



After freshening-up at the hotel, we will proceed for a tour of the world's smallest country, Vatican City.

Home to the Pope, Vatican City is an independent country with a population of just 800 people located within the city of Rome. We will start the sightseeing tour of the Vatican with a visit to St Peter's Square. This beautiful space with glorious fountains and Egyptian Obelisks is the place where people gather every Wednesday to see the pope and seek his blessings. Next we will visit St Peter's Basilica. Built on the same spot where St Peter was buried, the basilica is a awe-inspiring church with breath-taking beauty enshrined in its religious sculptures built by famous artists such as Michelangelo.

DAY 02: ROME CITY TOUR

After breakfast at the hotel, we will proceed for a city tour of Rome to see some of Rome's best-preserved ancient sites.

We will start the city tour with a visit to the Colosseum, one of the new seven wonders of the world. With a seating capacity of 80,000 spectators, it was the largest amphitheater in the world at the time of its construction in 72 AD. Its arena was used for gladiator fights, animal hunting, reenactments of famous battles and mythological plays. After the





tour of Colosseum, we will take a tour of the Roman Forum, an iconic plaza at the hub of daily life in ancient Rome. Important public affairs such as elections and public speeches











were conducted at the Roman Forum, which is dotted with ruins of the Senate House, Temple of Saturn and more.





Later proceed to Trevi fountain. Made in Baroque style using Travertine Stone, it is believed that wishes come true for all those who make a wish at the fountain and throw a coin. We will also visit the Pantheon, an iconic temple built for Roman Gods in 126 A.D., it was later consecrated as a Christina Church. The tour shall end at Piazza Navona, a bustling square with beautiful fountains, street artists and painters.

DAY 03: TRANSFER TO FLORENCE AND WALKING TOUR

After breakfast, we will check out from the hotel and transfer to Rome Train Station. To catch a train to the city of Florence.

During Medieval times, Florence was one of the wealthiest cities in the world and was at the centre of arts and culture. Today, Florence occupies a place in the hearts of art aficionados and is the capital of the beautiful Tuscany region of Italy. The city features artworks by the most notable personalities such as Leonardo Da Vinci, Michelangelo, Dante and Botticelli. Financially backed by the powerful Medici family of Florence, these greats gave birth to the Renaissance movement that spread throughout the world.













After freshening up at the hotel. Head out for a walking tour of the lively Historic centre of Florence, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Here, at Piazza del Duomo, you shall witness the beauty of the majestic Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore, the Baptistry, Campanile of Giotto and several others notable buildings. The architecture of these buildings, their surrounding sculptures and their artwork are products of 600 years of profound artistic activity in the region in the 15th and 16th century. Marvel at the most famous sculpture in the world, that of David by Michelangelo at Gallerie Dell'Academia.

SEGV'S RECOMMENDATION - Originally built as an office complex for the powerful Medici family of Florence, the private viewing gallery on the top floor expanded to occupy the whole building which is now called the Uffizi Gallery, the world's largest collection of Renaissance art. For any art lover, this place is a must visit, featuring priceless artwork from some of the greatest artists of all time.

DAY 04: PISA, SIENA AND SAN GIMIGNANO TOUR WITH WINE TASTING

After breakfast at the hotel, we will proceed for a tour of the beautiful Tuscany region.

Begin the tour with a visit to the the medieval gem of Siena. Pass through the picturesque streets and explore main piazza of the city - Piazza del Campo. Other sights include the beautiful Siena Cathedral and Torre del Mangia.



Next, drive about one hour through the rolling hills of Tuscany to reach a lovely winery in the countryside outside of San Gimignano. Indulge in a wine tasting of high-level wines accompanied by a delicious typical Tuscan meal with meat and cheese plate, pasta, and dessert.

Then drive onwards to the hilltop town of San Gimignano. Sometimes called a medieval Manhattan, San Gimignano is visible from close and far, with its unmistakable medieval "skyscrapers." there are still thirteen towers intact in this perfectly preserved hilltop











town. Viist the main square - Piazza della Cisterna, where you can find the Cathedral, Duomo, and lovely architecture.

Finally, visit the medieval city of Pisa. Here we will marvel at the iconic Leaning Tower of Pisa which is renowned world over for its outrageous slant. Also located in the same complex, the cathedral and cemetery are architectural marvels that play with white marbles and colourful mosaics. The baptistry, also located nearby, is famous for its amazing acoustic design which allowed the bishop to communicate with the people without using a mike.

DAY 05: TRANSFER TO VENICE AND ENJOY ICONIC GONDOLA RIDE

After breakfast at the hotel, we will check-out from the hotel and proceed to the train station to catch a train to Venice. Upon arriving, we will check-in at our city centre hotel there.

Considered to be the most romantic city in the world, Venice is built on an archipelago of 100 small islands that are intersected by multitudes of canals. The sleek and elegantly shaped gondolas that are used to transport the people and magnificent palatial buildings



exude the old-world charm that is characteristic of the city. One of the greatest sea ports of medieval Europe, it was the melting pot of European, Middle Eastern and Asian culture.

In the evening, we will hop on a gondola to enjoy a Grand Canal Cruise of Venice. These flat-bottom wooden boats takes you along the canals and narrow waterways of Venice. Just sit back and relax, as you enjoy the relaxing rhythm of water waves while being driven around by an expert gondolier.

DAY 07: EXCURSION OF DOLOMITES

After breakfast at the hotel, proceed for a full day hiking tour to Seceda by your self-drive vehicle.

It is distinguished by its expansive, sweeping alpine meadows as well as its striking, jagged peaks that pierce the sky. Ride the cable car up to the top. The ride itself offers amazing views, and at the summit met with mind-blowing panoramic vistas that highlight the Dolomites' natural splendor. With the fresh, oxygen-rich air of the high Alps around them, you can view rolling meadows, untamed cliffs, and far-off mountain ranges from this advantageous location.

Seceda offers more than just breathtaking scenery; it gives visitors a flavor of the regional way of life. The scenery is dotted with mountain cottages and refugios, which offer warm places to relax and savor regional cuisine from South Tyrol. Guests may











enjoy the region's culinary legacy while taking in the views at these rustic cafés, which provide hearty meals created with local ingredients.

Next we will check out the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, the oldest shopping arcade in Italy which houses exclusive high-end boutiques and stores of famous luxury brands such as Louis Vuitton, Gucci and Prada.
