DAY 01: ARRIVAL AT REYKJAVIK AIRPORT

On arrival at Keflavík International Airport in Iceland, you will be greeted by our local representative before proceeding to Reykjavík for hotel check-in. After a brief rest, take a short detour to witness the dramatic lava landscapes of the Reykjanes Peninsula. Shaped by ancient volcanic eruptions, these vast black lava fields offer a truly unique and otherworldly sight.

In the evening, we will head out to experience the Northern Lights, also known as the Aurora Borealis. Iceland is among the best places in the world to witness this stunning natural display, which occurs when charged solar particles collide with the Earth's magnetic field, painting the sky in brilliant shades of green, purple, and pink.

DAY 02: REYKJAVIK CITY TOUR & WONDERS OF ICELAND

Enjoy a guided tour of Reykjavik, starting with a photo stop at the Solfar sculpture on the waterfront. Take a walk along the lively main street, Laugavegur, and explore the harbor area. Visit Hallgrim's Church, the largest church in Iceland, known for its striking design and impressive pipe organ. Climb to the church tower for a panoramic view of the city.



Next, visit the Presidential Residence at Bessastaðir, followed by a photo stop at Hofdi House, where the historic 1986 summit between President Ronald Reagan and Secretary General Mikhail Gorbachev took place. See the iconic Harpa Concert Hall from the outside, known for its unique glass architecture. Experience the thrilling FlyOver Iceland ride, offering a breathtaking virtual flight over the country's stunning landscapes.














Later, visit the Perlan Museum, also known as the Wonders of Iceland. Explore fascinating exhibits, including a real indoor ice cave, the Wonders of Iceland display, Water in Icelandic Nature, and the Áróra Northern Lights Planetarium Show, providing an immersive experience of Iceland's natural beauty.

DAY 03: VISIT TO GOLDEN CIRCLE AND THE GREAT GEYSER GEOTHERMAL AREA

After breakfast, we will proceed to visit the Golden Circle in Southern Iceland. The Golden Circle is one of the most famous of all scenic routes in Iceland and combines stunning landmarks and historically significant places in a circular sightseeing tour.

The three primary stops on the route are the Thingvellir National Park, the Gullfoss waterfall, and the geothermal area in Haukadalur, which contains the geysers Geysir and Strokkur.













Proceed to the Great Geyser geothermal area where you can see bubbling hot springs & the geyser Strokkur erupting about every 10 minutes to a 15-20 meter height followed by a visit to the massive Gullfoss, translated as Golden Falls, one of the most popular waterfalls of Iceland.

Overnight stay at hotel in Hvolsvollur.

DAY 04: SOUTH ICELAND ADVENTURE & GLACIER LAGOON

Today, take a journey along the stunning south route, which gained popularity among Indian travelers through the Bollywood song *Gerua*. Begin with a photo stop at Seljalandsfoss, a magnificent 180-foot-tall waterfall known for its unique walking path that allows visitors to experience it from behind. Pass by the infamous Eyjafjallajökull volcano, which erupted in 2010 and disrupted air travel across Europe for nearly a week.











Proceed to Skogafoss, one of Iceland's largest and most picturesque waterfalls. With a width of approximately 50 feet and a drop of 200 feet, it has been a popular filming location. On a sunny day, lucky visitors may witness a single or even a double rainbow in the mist. Continue the journey to Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach, famous for its striking basalt column formations, known as Gardar, resembling a rocky step pyramid. Enjoy the breathtaking view of the Reynisdrangar stone stacks emerging from the Atlantic Ocean.



Later, visit Jokulsarlon Glacier Lagoon, one of nature's greatest wonders, where giant icebergs drift across the tranquil waters. Experience a 40-minute amphibian boat ride (subject to weather conditions) to get up close to these floating ice sculptures. After a day of exploring Iceland's natural beauty, proceed to the Höfn area.

Overnight Stay at the hotel in Höfn area.

DAY 05: JOURNEY TO NORTH ICELAND & DETTIFOSS WATERFALL

After breakfast at hotel, Today, travel to Lake Myvatn, located in northern Iceland and formed by a massive lava eruption 2,300 years ago. En route, visit Dettifoss (subject to operation), Europe's most powerful waterfall, which releases 500 cubic meters of water per second from its 45-meter-high and 100-meter-wide edge, creating a breathtaking sight.

Continue the journey through Namaskard Pass, a geothermal area known for its boiling mud pools and strikingly colorful surroundings. The distinct sulfuric smell in the air is a reminder of the volcanic activity beneath the surface. Take a photo stop at Lake Myvatn, situated along the western side of Iceland's volcanic zone, which is an extension of the Mid-Atlantic Ridge. The lake's unique landscape and geological significance make it a must-visit destination. After an eventful day, proceed to the hotel.

Overnight stay at hotel in Myvatn.

DAY 06: WHALE WATCHING & WATERFALL OF THE GODS

After breakfast at hotel, travel to Húsavík, known as the whale-watching capital of Iceland and one of the best places in the world to observe these majestic marine creatures up close (subject to weather conditions). Experience the thrill of spotting different whale species in their natural habitat.

Later, proceed to Godafoss, the "Waterfall of the Gods," a breath-taking cascade with a rich history and stunning views. In the evening, enjoy free time to stroll through the charming town of Akureyri, known for its picturesque streets, cozy cafes, and beautiful fjord views.

Overnight stay at hotel in Akureyri.

DAY 07: INTO THE GLACIER - ICELAND'S ICE CAVES

Today, proceed to Husafell, the base camp for the unforgettable *Into the Glacier* experience, a once-in-a-lifetime adventure. Explore the ice tunnel and caves inside Langjokull, Europe's second-largest glacier, with ice reaching up to 1,900 feet in thickness.

Discover the mesmerizing ice chapel and learn about the glacier's formation, glacial exploration, and ongoing research on global warming. Witness firsthand the stunning beauty of the frozen landscape. In the evening, arrive in Reykjavik and check in at the hotel.

DAY 08: DEPARTURE

After breakfast, pamper yourself at the Blue Lagoon geothermal spa - the most visited attraction in Iceland. The spa is located in a lava field in Grindavik on the Reykjanes Peninsula.

After the relaxing Spa retreat, you will transfer to the international airport to board a flight to India.
