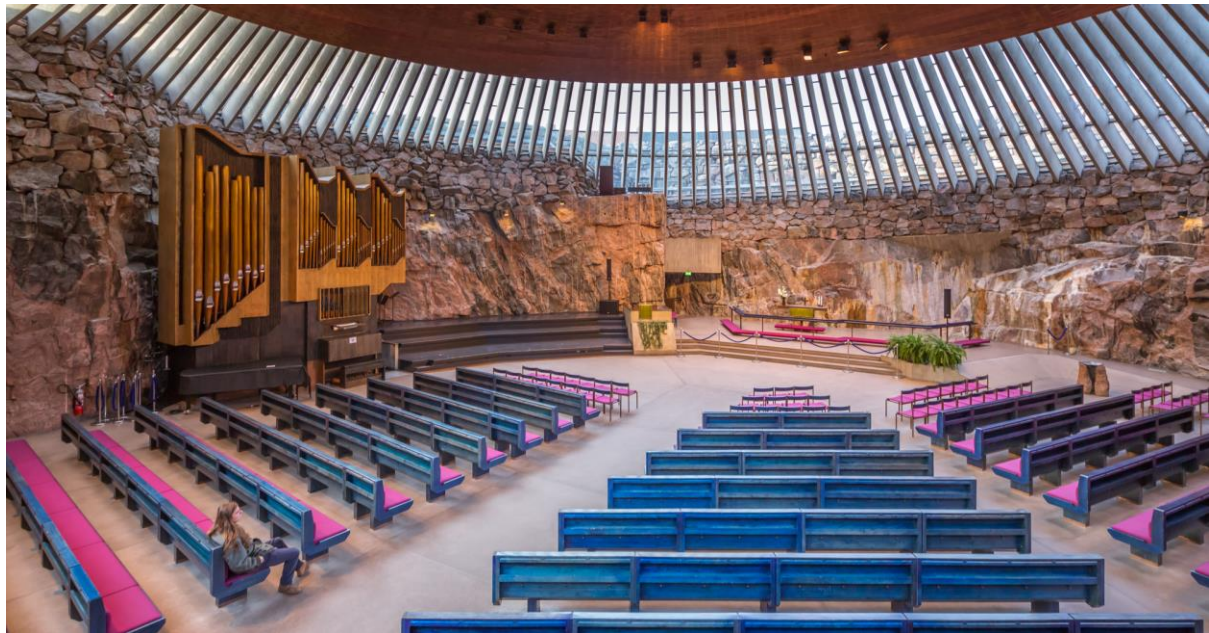
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DAY 01: ARRIVE IN HELSINKI AND VISIT TO ROCK CHURCH

Upon arrival at the airport, transfer to your hotel in Helsinki.

Helsinki is the capital city of Finland, celebrated as the happiest country in the world. Known for its harmony of modern architecture and natural surroundings, Helsinki is also home to innovative design hubs, charming waterfronts, and the iconic Design District that showcases Nordic creativity.



Proceed to visit the **Rock Church (Tempeliaukio Church)**, a striking architectural marvel hewn directly from solid rock and topped with a copper dome. This Lutheran church is one of Helsinki's most visited attractions, admired for its raw beauty and brilliant acoustics that create a tranquil ambiance.

Overnight stay at hotel in Helsinki.

DAY 02: HELSINKI CITY TOUR

After breakfast at hotel, proceed for a city tour of Helsinki.

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Drive past the bustling harbor and shipyards, then continue along the scenic coastal road lined with embassies. Visit the colorful **Open-air market** and **Senate Square**, home to the elegant Lutheran Cathedral. Explore **Esplanadi**, a lively shopping street lined with designer boutiques.



Visit the **Sibelius Monument**, dedicated to Finland's famous composer Jean Sibelius. Later, continue along Mannerheim Street to view the **Parliament House**, the **National Museum**, and **Finlandia Hall** – a renowned concert and conference venue designed by Alvar Aalto. Pass by the Olympic Stadium, which hosted the 1952 Summer Games.

Later in the afternoon, proceed to the pier to board the overnight **Silja Line cruise** to Stockholm.

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DAY 03: TRANSFER TO STOCKHOLM AND VISIT TO VASA MUSEUM

After breakfast at the hotel, check out from the hotel and transfer to Stockholm. **Stockholm** – the capital of Sweden, a city spread across 14 islands, blending nature with innovation.



Known as the “**Venice of the North**,” Stockholm is celebrated for its music, design, and Nobel Prize legacy.

Visit the **Drottningholm Palace**, Sweden’s best-preserved royal palace and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Built in the 17th century, it remains the permanent residence of the Swedish royal family. Later, continue for a guided city tour of Stockholm. Visit

Fjällgatan for panoramic views of the archipelago. Explore the cobblestoned streets of **Gamla Stan** (Old Town), see the **Royal Palace**, the **Cathedral**, and the **City Hall** – famous for hosting the Nobel Prize banquet.

Proceed to visit the **Vasa Museum**, home to the 17th-century warship Vasa, which sank on its maiden voyage and was later salvaged in near-perfect condition. The museum offers a captivating look into Swedish maritime history. Later, enjoy a ride to the top of the **SkyView gondola** on the world’s largest spherical building for stunning views of the city.



Overnight stay at hotel in Stockholm.

DAY 04: TRANSFER TO OSLO VIA KARLSTAD

After breakfast at Hotel, proceed to Oslo – the capital of Norway, with an en route visit to the beautiful town of Karlstad.

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Karlstad, nestled along the northern shores of Lake Vänern and bisected by the serene Klarälven River, is a picturesque town known for its sunshine symbol and peaceful vibe. The town square, **Karlstad Square**, is a local highlight, surrounded by quaint cafés and public art. Pause for a photo stop here and experience the calm essence of this scenic lakeside destination.

Later, continue the journey towards **Oslo** – a modern and culturally vibrant city nestled between the Oslofjord and forested hills. Oslo is renowned for its green spaces, Nordic design, and deep Viking heritage. Upon arrival, check in and unwind at the hotel.

Overnight stay at hotel in Oslo.

DAY 05: VISIT TO VIGELAND PARK AND TRANSFER TO GEILO

After breakfast at hotel, proceed for a city tour of Oslo.



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Begin the day with a visit to **Vigeland Sculpture Park**, an artistic wonderland housing over 200 bronze and granite sculptures by Gustav Vigeland. The park beautifully portrays the range of human emotions through expressive forms. Proceed to the **Museum of Cultural History**, which showcases Norway's rich archaeological and ethnographic collections. Later, visit the iconic **Holmenkollen Ski Jump**, one of the world's oldest ski jumps and an enduring symbol of Norwegian winter sports. Enjoy panoramic views of Oslo from the top.

After sightseeing, drive through scenic mountain landscapes to the town of **Geilo**, known for its alpine charm.

Overnight stay at hotel in Geilo.

DAY 06: EXPERIENCE JORD CRUISE AND TRANSFER TO BERGEN

The city offers a perfect blend of old-world charm and modern vibrancy. On arrival, check in and relax amidst the serene coastal ambiance.

DAY 07: BERGEN CITY TOUR AND VISIT TO MT. FLØYEN

After breakfast at hotel, explore Bergen city, remarkable for its unparalleled beauty.

Stroll along **Bryggen**, the UNESCO World Heritage Site with vibrant wooden houses dating back to the Hanseatic League era. Discover the city's rich seafaring legacy and lively fish markets. Proceed to **Mt. Fløyen** and take the **Fløybanen** funicular to the top. Enjoy sweeping views of Bergen and its surrounding fjords and peaks. Later in the afternoon, board the **Fjordline Cruise** from Bergen to Hirtshals, Denmark. Enjoy the facilities on board as the cruise sails through the North Sea.

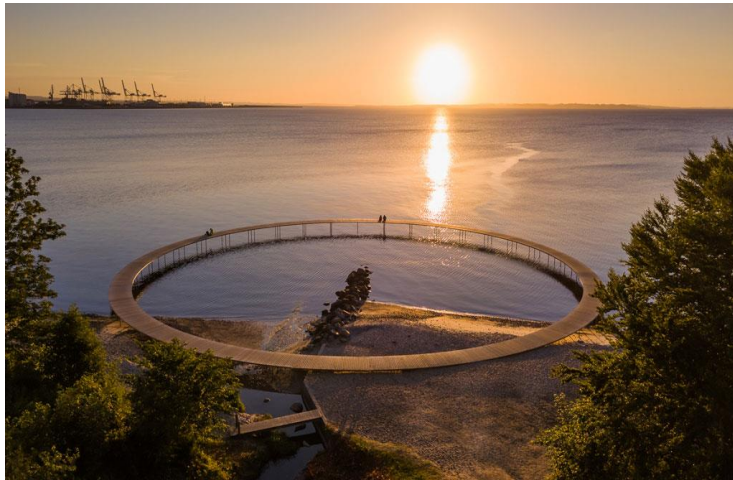

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DAY 08: TRIP TO AARHUS, H.C. ANDERSEN MUSEUM VISIT AND TRANSFER TO COPENHAGEN

After breakfast at Hotel, disembark from the cruise at Hirtshals and drive to Aarhus for a day tour.



Aarhus, Denmark's second-largest city, is a thriving cultural hub blending modern design with historic charm. Begin with an orientation tour covering key landmarks of the city. Make a scenic photo stop at the **Infinite Bridge** — a unique circular bridge extending into the sea, offering uninterrupted panoramic views where the sky meets the water.

Later, enjoy lunch in Aarhus before continuing the journey to **Odense**. Known as the birthplace of legendary storyteller Hans Christian Andersen, Odense is deeply rooted in fairy-tale history. Visit the **H.C. Andersen Museum**, which celebrates the life and literary contributions of the beloved author. The museum offers a rich narrative through his personal items, manuscripts, and interactive displays.



Continue the drive to **Copenhagen**, the lively and sophisticated capital of Denmark. Known for its historic architecture, contemporary lifestyle, and strong biking culture, the city is an ideal blend of tradition and innovation.

Overnight stay at hotel in Copenhagen.

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DAY 09: COPENHAGEN CITY TOUR

After breakfast at hotel, proceed for a guided tour of Copenhagen.

Begin the day with a scenic **Nyhavn canal cruise**, offering stunning views of the city's colorful buildings and historic harbors. Cruise past famous landmarks and enjoy the vibrant waterfront. Later, drive to Roskilde for an orientation tour.
