DAY 01: ARRIVAL IN LISBON

Upon arrival at Lisbon airport, you will be met by your tour representative and transfer to your hotel for check-in and a brief orientation about the upcoming journey.

Lisbon, the capital city of Portugal, is a vibrant blend of history, culture, and coastal beauty, known for its cobbled streets, pastel-coloured buildings, and soulful Fado music. It's one of the oldest cities in Western Europe, predating cities like London and Paris.



Spend the rest of the day exploring the city at leisure. Take a stroll through the historic Alfama district or visit the bustling Baixa area filled with shops and cafes.

DAY 02: LISBON CITY TOUR AND SUNSET EXPERIENCE

After breakfast at hotel, enjoy a city tour of Lisbon by Tuk Tuk or Tram 28.



Explore Lisbon's oldest quarters including Alfama, Graça, and Bairro Alto. Ride past the Lisbon Cathedral and stop at scenic viewpoints such as Miradouro da Senhora do Monte. Continue towards the São Jorge Castle and pass by Praça do Comércio, the grand riverfront square that reflects Lisbon's maritime heritage.



In the evening, head towards the riverside for a relaxing sunset river cruise or opt for a walking food tour with drinks. The cruise offers panoramic views of Lisbon's skyline, while the food tour lets travelers indulge in traditional Portuguese dishes paired with local wines.

SEGV RECOMMENDATION: For those not opting for the sunset activities, a visit to the LX Factory — a trendy cultural space with boutiques and cafes — is recommended.

Overnight stay at hotel in Lisbon.

DAY 03: FOOTBALL STADIUM TOUR AND TRANSFER TO ALGARVE REGION

After breakfast at hotel, visit Estádio da Luz, the iconic home of Benfica Football Club.



Tour the stadium and its museum, where historic trophies, legendary player memorabilia, and interactive exhibits celebrate the club's rich football legacy. Walk through the players' tunnel, visit the locker rooms, and get a feel of the electrifying energy inside this worldfamous venue.











Later, check out and transfer to the Algarve region. The Algarve is Portugal's southernmost region, known for its sun-kissed coastline, golden beaches, and whitewashed fishing villages that blend tradition with vibrant nightlife.

Overnight stay at hotel in Lagos

DAY 04: BENAGIL CAVE TOUR

After breakfast at hotel, set out on a tour to explore the famous Benagil Cave along the Algarve coastline.

Board a boat or kayak to visit the spectacular sea cave, known for its unique dome ceiling and golden sandstone formations. The tour offers views of hidden beaches, turquoise waters, and dramatic cliffs, making it a highlight of the Algarve experience.

Later, spend time relaxing by the beach or exploring local cafés and restaurants by the coast.

DAY 05: LEISURE DAY IN THE ALGARVE

After breakfast at hotel, enjoy a full day of leisure in the Algarve region.

Spend the day sunbathing on picturesque beaches, visiting local markets, or exploring nearby towns like Lagos with its charming streets and historic fort walls. Those seeking adventure can opt for water sports or dolphin-watching cruises.



SEGV RECOMMENDATION: Consider visiting Praia da Marinha or taking a coastal hiking trail like the Seven Hanging Valleys for stunning sea views.

DAY 06: TRANSFER TO SEVILLE

After breakfast at hotel, transfer by bus to Seville in southern Spain.

DAY 07: SEVILLE CITY TOUR WITH GUADALQUIVIR RIVER CRUISE AND **BULLFIGHT EXPERIENCE**

After breakfast at hotel, embark on a guided city tour of Seville.

Visit key landmarks such as the Seville Cathedral — one of the largest in the world, and the Real Alcázar — a royal palace blending Moorish and Renaissance styles. Explore Santa Cruz, the old Jewish quarter, with its labyrinth of whitewashed alleys and picturesque courtyards. Later, enjoy a scenic cruise on the Guadalquivir River, offering a different perspective of Seville's landmarks and bridges.



Later in the evening, watch a traditional bullfight at Seville's historic Plaza de Toros. The event offers insight into Spain's controversial yet culturally significant tradition of bullfighting.

SEGV RECOMMENDATION: Those not keen on bullfighting can opt for a relaxed river walk along the Guadalquivir or explore Metropol Parasol for panoramic city views.

DAY 08: TRANSFER TO MADRID AND ENJOY FLAMENCO SHOW

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to Madrid by high-speed train.

Madrid is the capital of Spain and a cultural hub known for its grand boulevards, royal landmarks, and world-class museums. It represents a dynamic mix of tradition and modernity with architectural elegance and vibrant street life.



Later in the evening, attend an authentic Flamenco show — an expressive dance form deeply rooted in Spanish culture, accompanied by soulful guitar and vocals.

Overnight stay at hotel in Madrid.

DAY 09: MADRID CITY TOUR WITH ROYAL PALACE AND TAPAS EVENING

After breakfast at hotel, begin a guided walking tour of Madrid with a visit to the Royal Palace.

DAY 11: COSTA BRAVA DAY TOUR FROM BARCELONA

- Explore fishing villages and sea cliffs


DAY 12: LEISURE DAY IN BARCELONA

SEGV RECOMMENDATION: Visit La Roca Village, a designer outlet located just outside the city with over 140 fashion and lifestyle boutiques offering year-round discounts. Alternatively, take a half-day tour to Montserrat, a mountain-top monastery known for its unique rock formations, spiritual ambiance, and panoramic views.

Overnight stay at hotel in Barcelona.

DAY 13: DEPARTURE FROM BARCELONA

After breakfast at hotel, proceed to visit Camp Nou, the legendary stadium of FC Barcelona.

Later, transfer to the airport for departure from Barcelona, concluding a memorable journey through Portugal and Spain filled with cultural experiences, historic sites, and coastal beauty.
