DAY 01: ARRIVAL IN LISBON

Upon arrival at Lisbon airport, you will be met by your tour representative and transfer to your hotel for check-in and a brief orientation about the upcoming journey.

DAY 02: LISBON SKYWALK: OLD TOWN, HELICOPTER FLIGHT AND SAILING WATERFRONT

After breakfast at hotel, begin the day with an immersive 360° experience of Lisbon that combines land, air, and water.

Start with a guided walking tour through the heart of Lisbon's old town. Stroll through historic neighborhoods that reflect the city's deep maritime roots and Moorish influences. Admire the tile-covered façades, charming alleyways, and important landmarks that narrate the story of Portugal's capital. Later, board the iconic yellow streetcar and glide through the city's most picturesque routes, soaking in Lisbon's unique urban charm.













Proceed to the Tagus River and set sail toward Belém, an area rich in historical significance. Belém is home to some of Portugal's most iconic monuments, including the Belém Tower, a UNESCO World Heritage Site symbolizing the Age of Discoveries, and the Monument to the Discoveries, which honors Portuguese explorers. The sailing experience offers breathtaking views of Lisbon's skyline from the water, merging history with tranquility.

Proceed to enjoy a helicopter flight and witness panoramic views of Lisbon's red rooftops, the riverfront, and major landmarks from above. This aerial perspective offers a memorable conclusion to the day's unique multi-experience tour.

DAY 03: HALF DAY TOUR TO FATIMA

After breakfast at hotel, proceed for a half-day shared coach tour to the spiritual town of Fatima.











Located approximately 125 km from Lisbon, Fatima is one of the most important pilgrimage sites in the world. It became globally renowned in 1917 when three young shepherd children claimed to have seen multiple apparitions of the Virgin Mary. Since then, Fatima has drawn millions of believers and visitors each year seeking peace, reflection, and faith.



Begin the tour with a visit to the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Fatima, a sacred complex that includes the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary, where the tombs of the three visionary children—Lucia, Francisco, and Jacinta—are located. Later, proceed to the Cova da Iria, the pasture where the apparitions took place, and the Chapel of the Apparitions, which stands on the very site where the Virgin is said to have first appeared. These solemn sites offer a moving experience and insight into the deep spiritual resonance of the region.













Return to Lisbon by afternoon. The rest of the day is free to explore the city at your own pace. Consider walking through the bustling streets of Chiado or enjoying a riverside coffee in the relaxed atmosphere of Cais do Sodré.

DAY 04: ESTORIL COAST AND SINTRA TOUR FROM LISBON

After breakfast at hotel, set out for a scenic and cultural journey through Sintra, Cabo da Roca, Cascais, and Estoril.



Proceed with a visit to Sintra, a UNESCO World Heritage Site nestled in the lush hills northwest of This fairvtale Lisbon. town is celebrated for its romantic architecture and roval heritage. Explore the Palácio da Vila, one of the oldest palaces in Portugal, which served as summer retreat for the Portuguese Royal Family

until 1910. Known for its twin chimneys and intricate tilework, the palace reflects centuries of royal history. Take time to browse the local craft shops and enjoy Sintra's famous pastries—queijadas and travesseiros, both beloved traditional sweets that offer a taste of the region's culinary legacy.

Later, proceed to Cabo da Roca, the westernmost point of continental Europe. Standing atop dramatic cliffs overlooking the Atlantic, this rugged headland offers a magnificent panoramic view and a profound sense of geographic significance. Continue the journey along the windswept coastline, passing by the stunning Praia do Guincho, a beach known for its natural beauty and popular among surfers.





Proceed to Cascais, an elegant seaside town once favored by European aristocracy. Stop by the Boca do Inferno, a striking cliff formation where ocean waves crash into the caves below, creating a thunderous spectacle. Enjoy views of the beautiful Bay of Cascais before driving back through Estoril, a stylish coastal town known for its lush gardens, beachfront promenade, and the iconic Estoril Casino, one of the largest in Europe.

Overnight stay at hotel in Lisbon.

DAY 05: TRANSFER TO PORTO And HALF DAY TOUR OF AVEIRO

After breakfast at hotel, check out and board a train to Porto, Portugal's second-largest city and a UNESCO World Heritage Site located along the Douro River.

Porto is renowned for its historic center, rich architectural heritage, and the globally celebrated Port wine. With its colorful riverside buildings, ornate churches, and vibrant cultural life, Porto offers a distinct charm that sets it apart from Lisbon. Upon arrival, check in at your hotel and take some time to settle in.













In the afternoon, proceed for a half-day tour to Aveiro, often referred to as the "Venice of Portugal" due to its picturesque canals and traditional moliceiro boats. Located just south of Porto, Aveiro is known for its Art Nouveau architecture, salt pans, and sweet ovos moles pastries. Glide through the city's waterways aboard a vividly painted moliceiro—boats originally used to harvest seaweed—and take in views of charming pastel-colored buildings, decorative facades, and quaint bridges that make this town a hidden gem of central Portugal.

Overnight stay at hotel in Porto.

DAY 06: VISIT TO DUORO VALLEY
