

## **DAY 01: ARRIVE IN PARIS**

Upon arrival at the airport, transfer to your hotel in Paris.



Paris, the capital of France, is widely known as the "City of Lights" and is a global hub for fashion, art, gastronomy, and culture. The city is a perfect blend of historic monuments, romantic boulevards, and café-lined streets. Whether it's your first visit or a return, Paris always manages to enchant with its elegance and energy.

Spend the rest of the day at leisure exploring the area near your hotel, perhaps taking an evening stroll along the Seine or sipping coffee in a cozy bistro.

## DAY 02: PARIS CITY TOUR AND EIFFEL TOWER VISIT

After breakfast at hotel, proceed for a half-day guided city tour to explore the iconic

landmarks of Paris.

Begin with a drive past Place de la Concorde, the city's grandest square known for its Egyptian obelisk and historical significance. Continue along the Avenue des Champs-Élysées, one of the world's most beautiful avenues, leading to the Arc de Triomphe, a monument honouring those who fought for France.





Later, proceed to the Eiffel Tower for a priority access visit to the second floor. This iron lattice marvel, designed by Gustave Eiffel, offers spectacular panoramic views over the entire cityscape from its elevated viewing platforms.



Enjoy a one-hour Seine River cruise, gliding past Paris's historic bridges and UNESCO World Heritage-listed riverbanks. Admire landmarks such as Notre-Dame Cathedral, the Louvre Museum, and the Grand Palais from the calm waters of the Seine.

## DAY 03: DAY AT LEISURE

Visit the Montmartre district, home to the Basilique du Sacré-Cœur and the birthplace of many famous artists, or take time to enjoy a macaron at Ladurée. Explore hidden courtyards, fashionable boutiques, or simply enjoy a croissant in a corner café.













SEGV RECOMMENDATION: Opt for a visit to the Louvre Museum, home to masterpieces like the Mona Lisa and Venus de Milo. Alternatively, consider a visit to the Palace of Versailles, a symbol of royal opulence and architectural grandeur.

## **DAY 04: TRANSFER TO INTERLAKEN**

After breakfast at hotel, check out and board the TGV to Basel followed by a connecting train to Interlaken.

Interlaken, nestled between Lake Thun and Lake Brienz, is a picture-perfect town in the heart of the Bernese Oberland. Framed by the Eiger, Mönch, and Jungfrau mountains, Interlaken is famous for its scenic beauty and outdoor adventures.

Stroll along the famous Höhematte Park or the Hoheweg boulevard, lined with boutique shops, traditional Swiss chocolatiers, and alpine cafés.

## DAY 05: EXCURSION TO JUNGFRAUJOCH

After breakfast at hotel, begin the day with a thrilling excursion to Jungfraujoch, the highest train station in Europe.

## DAY 06: GOLDEN PASS PANORAMIC JOURNEY AND TRANSFER TO LUCERNE

After breakfast at hotel, take the scenic train from Interlaken to Lucerne, one of Switzerland's most beautiful journeys.

Lucerne, set beside a crystal-clear lake and surrounded by mountains, blends medieval charm with modern vibrancy. The iconic Chapel Bridge, Lion Monument, and lively Old Town draw travelers from across the globe.



Enjoy the rest of the day to explore on your own. Walk by Lake Lucerne, admire the frescoed buildings of the Old Town, or visit quaint local shops for Swiss souvenirs.

## DAY 07: FULL-DAY EXCURSION TO MOUNT TITLIS

After breakfast at hotel, leave for a memorable day trip to Mount Titlis—one of the most accessible snow peaks in Switzerland.



Board a train to Engelberg and ascend via cable car to Trübsee and then to Stand. The final leg of the journey is on the Titlis Rotair, the world's first revolving cable car, offering 360° views of the surrounding alpine landscape.

At the summit, explore the Glacier Cave with its magical ice tunnels, ride the Ice Flyer chairlift over crevasses, and walk across the Titlis Cliff Walk—Europe's highest suspension bridge.













Overnight stay at hotel in Lucerne.

## **DAY 08: TRANSFER TO VENICE**

After breakfast at hotel, check out and board a train to Venice via Milan.

Venice is an extraordinary city built on over 100 islands connected by canals and bridges. It is a living museum of Gothic, Renaissance, and Baroque architecture, with gondolas replacing cars and the Grand Canal acting as its main artery.



On arrival, take time to soak in the atmosphere—watch boats glide by historic buildings, enjoy gelato in a shaded piazza, or simply admire the Venetian skyline.

## DAY 09: VENICE CITY TOUR WITH GONDOLA RIDE

Stroll through Piazza San Marco and admire the exterior of St. Mark's Basilica, famed for its golden mosaics and domes. Pass by Doge's Palace and other architectural gems that reflect Venice's glorious past.



Later, enjoy a gondola ride through the narrow canals—an experience that captures the romantic essence of the city. Glide past centuries-old buildings, under arched bridges, and into quiet waterways.

# DAY 10: TRANSFER TO FLORENCE AND GUIDED TOUR WITH UFFIZI GALLERY VISIT

After breakfast at hotel, take a train from Venice to Florence.

Florence, the cradle of the Renaissance, is home to unparalleled artistic and architectural masterpieces. Its narrow cobbled streets open to grand piazzas and its skyline is crowned by the iconic Duomo.











Later, join a guided city tour starting at Santa Croce square and walk past medieval churches. Visit the Church of Santa Felicita, where you can admire works by Pontormo and the Vasari Corridor above. The highlight is the visit to the Uffizi Gallery, housing iconic works by Botticelli, Michelangelo, and Leonardo da Vinci.

## DAY 11: PISA TOUR FROM FLORENCE
