DAY 01: ARRIVE IN AUCKLAND

After arrival at Auckland International Airport, transfer to the hotel and check in.

Auckland, known to Māori as Tāmaki Makaurau, is the largest city in New Zealand and often called the "City of Sails" because of its beautiful harbours filled with yachts. It is built on a volcanic field and offers a blend of modern culture, scenic coastlines, and lush landscapes, making it the perfect starting point to explore the country.



Take some time to relax or explore the city at leisure. Walk along the Viaduct Harbour, admire the Sky Tower from a distance, or simply experience the charm of this vibrant waterfront city.

Overnight stay at hotel in Auckland.

- Arrival in Auckland, New Zealand's largest city
- Leisure time to explore Auckland's harbour and surroundings.

DAY 02: TRANSFER TO ROTORUA VIA WAITOMO

After breakfast at hotel, proceed towards Rotorua with an enroute visit to Waitomo Glowworm Caves.









The Waitomo Glowworm Caves are world famous for their bioluminescent glowworms which light up the underground chambers. A guided boat ride through the limestone caves reveals this magical natural spectacle that feels like a starlit sky underground.



Later, continue the journey to Rotorua, the geothermal hub of New Zealand. Known for its bubbling mud pools, erupting geysers, and rich Māori culture, Rotorua is one of the most visited places in the North Island.

Overnight stay at hotel in Rotorua.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Visit to the magical Waitomo Glowworm Caves
- Arrival in Rotorua, the geothermal and cultural heart of New Zealand.

DAY 03: ROTORUA HIGHLIGHTS – FARM FUN & GEOTHERMAL WONDERS

After breakfast at hotel, visit the famous Agrodome Farm.

The Agrodome is known for its entertaining farm show featuring sheep shearing, working dogs, and insights into New Zealand's agricultural life. It is an engaging way to experience the country's rural traditions.













Later, proceed to visit Whakarewarewa – The Living Māori Village. This village sits on active geothermal land with bubbling mud pools and steaming vents. It offers a unique opportunity to learn about Māori culture, daily life, and legends that connect the people with the land.

Overnight stay at hotel in Rotorua.

- Exploration of Whakarewarewa geothermal Māori village

DAY 04: AUCKLAND CITY TOUR & SKY TOWER EXPERIENCE

After breakfast at hotel, return to Auckland and enjoy a guided city tour.

The tour includes Auckland's iconic landmarks such as Parnell's historic architecture, Viaduct Harbour, Ponsonby's vibrant streets, and the scenic waterfront. These sites reflect the cosmopolitan charm of Auckland alongside its coastal beauty.













Later, proceed to visit the Sky Tower, New Zealand's tallest building. From its viewing deck, enjoy panoramic views of Auckland city, the harbours, and the surrounding volcanic hills.

Overnight stay at hotel in Auckland.

DAY 05: TRANSFER TO QUEENSTOWN

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to Auckland Airport for a domestic flight to Queenstown.

Queenstown is situated on the shores of Lake Wakatipu and surrounded by the Remarkables mountain range. It is renowned worldwide as the adventure capital of New Zealand, offering both adrenaline-filled activities and tranquil landscapes.



The rest of the day is free for leisure to explore the lakefront, stroll through its cafés, or simply enjoy the alpine beauty of this resort town.

Overnight stay at hotel in Queenstown.

- Arrival in Queenstown, nestled amidst Lake Wakatipu and the Remarkables.









DAY 06: EXPLORE MILFORD SOUND CRUISE

After breakfast at hotel, proceed on a full-day excursion to Milford Sound.

Travel through Fiordland National Park, passing pristine lakes, rainforests, and towering peaks. The drive itself is regarded as one of the most scenic journeys in New Zealand.



Upon reaching Milford Sound, embark on a cruise to witness its dramatic fjord landscape. Enjoy sights of sheer cliffs, cascading waterfalls, and possible encounters with seals, dolphins, and penguins.

SEGV RECOMMENDATION: Helicopter flight over Milford Sound for an aerial view of the fjords (not included).

Overnight stay at hotel in Queenstown.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Scenic drive through Fiordland National Park
- Cruise experience on Milford Sound, known as the "Eighth Wonder of the World".









DAY 07: QUEENSTOWN CITY TOUR & SKYLINE GONDOLA

After breakfast at hotel, enjoy a city tour of Queenstown.

The tour covers the picturesque lakefront, vibrant streets, and viewpoints offering stunning vistas of the alpine surroundings. Queenstown is not only about adventure but also about charming urban exploration.



Later, proceed to ride the Skyline Gondola to the summit of Bob's Peak. From the top, take In breathtaking views of Lake Wakatipu, the Remarkables, and the town below.

Overnight stay at hotel in Queenstown.

HIGHLIGHTS

- City tour of Queenstown's scenic and cultural attractions
- Skyline Gondola ride to Bob's Peak with panoramic views.

DAY 08: TRANSFER TO FRANZ JOSEF VIA WANAKA

After breakfast at hotel, depart for Franz Josef with an enroute stop at Wanaka.

Wanaka is a charming lakeside town known for its outdoor adventures and the unique attraction of Puzzling World, where illusion rooms and puzzles provide an entertaining experience.













Continue through the Southern Alps, passing rainforests, lakes, and rugged mountain landscapes, before reaching Franz Josef. This village lies at the base of Franz Josef Glacier, one of the rare glaciers descending into a temperate rainforest.

Overnight stay at hotel in Franz Josef.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Stop at Wanaka and visit to Puzzling World
- Arrival at Franz Josef, home to one of the world's most unique glaciers.

DAY 09: TRANSFER TO CHRISTCHURCH

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to Greymouth to board the TranzAlpine Train.

The TranzAlpine is considered one of the greatest rail journeys in the world. It crosses the Southern Alps, passing through alpine valleys, deep river gorges, and snow-capped mountains before reaching Arthur's Pass.















Later, continue towards Christchurch across the Canterbury Plains. Christchurch, known as the Garden City, is famous for its English heritage, gardens, and innovation in urban design after the 2011 earthquake.

Overnight stay at hotel in Christchurch.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Scenic train ride on the world-famous TranzAlpine.
- Arrival in Christchurch, the Garden City of New Zealand.

DAY 10: TRIP TO THE ANTARCTIC CENTRE

After breakfast at hotel, visit the International Antarctic Centre.

The centre recreates the Antarctic experience through interactive exhibits, an Antarctic storm room, Hägglund vehicle rides, and encounters with husky dogs. It is one of Christchurch's most popular attractions.

Later, proceed on a city tour of Christchurch covering heritage sites, the Avon River, street art, and the city's beautiful parks and gardens.













Overnight stay at hotel in Christchurch.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Visit to the International Antarctic Centre
- Guided city tour of Christchurch.

DAY 11: DEPARTURE

After breakfast at hotel, check out and transfer to Airport for your onward flight.
