DAY 01: ARRIVE IN TOKYO AND EAST TOKYO TOUR

Arrive at airport and check-in at hotel, begin a captivating exploration of East and Central Tokyo covering some of the city's most iconic landmarks.



Start the day in Asakusa, one of Tokyo's oldest districts, known for preserving the charm of old Edo. Visit the magnificent Senso-ji Temple, Tokyo's oldest Buddhist temple, dedicated to the goddess Kannon. The temple's Thunder Gate and Nakamise Shopping Street create a lively atmosphere filled with traditional snacks, crafts, and souvenirs.

Later, proceed to Tokyo Skytree, Japan's tallest structure offering panoramic city views from its observation decks. The surrounding Solamachi complex features shops, restaurants, and an aquarium, making it a hub of modern Tokyo life. Continue to Ueno Park, a cultural oasis with museums, shrines, and natural beauty, especially famous for cherry blossoms in spring.





In the afternoon, visit the Imperial Palace East Gardens, part of the Emperor's residence grounds, where lush gardens and ancient stone walls reflect Japan's regal heritage.



SEGV RECOMMENDATION: Stop at Akihabara, Tokyo's electric town, renowned for anime, gaming, and electronic stores — a paradise for pop culture enthusiasts.

Overnight stay at hotel in Tokyo.

DAY 02: WEST TOKYO TOUR

After breakfast at hotel, continue the journey exploring the dynamic western and bayside areas of Tokyo.

Begin at Meiji Shrine, a tranquil Shinto shrine surrounded by a vast forest in the heart of the city. Dedicated to Emperor Meiji and Empress Shoken, the shrine symbolizes Japan's spiritual traditions amidst urban life. Walk through the nearby Harajuku district, famous for its youthful fashion, street art, and quirky boutiques, followed by a visit to Omotesando, a stylish avenue lined with designer stores and contemporary architecture.





Later, proceed to Shibuya Crossing, one of the busiest pedestrian crossings in the world, and visit the nearby Hachiko Statue, a touching symbol of loyalty and friendship. Continue to TeamLab Planets in Toyosu, an immersive digital art museum offering a mesmerizing, multi-sensory experience that blends light, water, and technology.



In the evening, head towards Odaiba Seaside Park, a man-made island offering stunning views of Tokyo Bay and the Gundam Statue, a life-sized marvel loved by anime fans. Conclude the day with dinner overlooking the illuminated Rainbow Bridge, enjoying a serene view of Tokyo's skyline.

DAY 03: MT. FUJI AND HAKONE TRIP FROM TOKYO

After breakfast at hotel. Embark on a full-day excursion to Mt. Fuji and Hakone, offering breathtaking views and a taste of Japan's natural beauty.

Drive towards Mt. Fuji, Japan's highest peak and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Ascend to the 5th Station (weather permitting) to witness panoramic views of the surrounding countryside and the mountain's majestic slopes. Mt. Fuji



holds spiritual significance in Japanese culture, symbolizing beauty and endurance.



Later, proceed to Hakone, a serene resort town known for its hot springs and scenic landscapes. Enjoy a Lake Ashi Cruise, offering picturesque views of Mt. Fuji reflected in the lake's tranquil waters. Later, take a ride on the Hakone Ropeway, gliding above volcanic valleys and steaming vents of the Owakudani area.

DAY 04: TRANSFER TO OSAKA

After breakfast at hotel. Today marks a journey from Tokyo to Osaka, Japan's vibrant hub of culture, cuisine, and nightlife.













Board the high-speed Shinkansen (bullet train) to Osaka. The city, located in Japan's Kansai region, is known for its lively atmosphere, mouth-watering street food, and friendly locals. Osaka has long been called "Japan's kitchen" for its food culture and was once the nation's commercial heart during the Edo period.

Upon arrival, visit Osaka Castle, one of Japan's most famous landmarks. The castle. originally built in the 16th century, stands as a symbol of unity under the rule Toyotomi Hideyoshi. proceed to Dotonbori, the entertainment and dining district known for its neon lights, lively canal, and iconic Glico Running Man sign.

DAY 05: NARA AND KYOTO TOUR FROM OSAKA

After breakfast at hotel. Enjoy a full-day excursion to two of Japan's most historic cities — Nara and Kyoto.



Drive to Nara, Japan's first permanent capital. Visit Todai-ji Temple, home to the Great Buddha (Daibutsu), one of Japan's largest bronze statues. The temple complex and the surrounding Nara Park are famous for their friendly, free-roaming deer that are considered messengers of the gods.











Later, proceed to Kyoto, the cultural heart of Japan, known for its temples, traditional and shrines. wooden houses. Visit the Fushimi Inari Shrine. renowned for its thousands of vermilion torii gates winding up the mountain. Continue to Kiyomizu-dera Temple, a UNESCO World Heritage Site offering panoramic views of Kyoto city from its wooden terrace.



Overnight stay at hotel in Osaka.
