DAY 01: ARRIVE IN MANILA

After breakfast at hotel, explore Intramuros, Fort Santiago, San Agustin Church and enjoy the sunset at Manila Bay.

Manila, the capital of the Philippines, blends Spanish colonial heritage with modern Filipino culture. Begin with Intramuros, the oldest district in the city, known for its cobblestone streets and fortified Spanish-era walls. Continue to Fort Santiago, a 16th-century citadel that played a significant role in the country's history and is closely associated with Philippine national hero Dr. José Rizal. Later, visit San Agustin Church, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that stands as the oldest stone church in the country, admired for its ornate interiors and baroque architecture.



Later, proceed to Manila Bay for its world-famous sunset views. The bay is one of the city's most iconic natural landmarks, known for its golden horizon and serene atmosphere.

Overnight stay at hotel in Manila.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Explore Intramuros, Manila's historic walled city
- Enjoy the iconic sunset at Manila Bay.

DAY 02: TRANSFER TO CEBU & CITY TOUR

After breakfast at hotel, fly to Cebu and visit Magellan's Cross and Basilica del Santo Niño, followed by an evening visit to Sugbo Mercado.













Cebu, often called the "Queen City of the South," is one of the Philippines' most culturally significant destinations. The city is known for its Spanish heritage, vibrant food scene, and historic sites that date back to the arrival of the Spanish explorers. Upon arrival, visit Magellan's Cross, a symbol marking the introduction of Christianity in the Philippines placed by Portuguese explorer Ferdinand Magellan. Continue to



the Basilica del Santo Niño, the country's oldest Roman Catholic Church, housing the revered Santo Niño de Cebu statue.

Later, proceed to Sugbo Mercado, Cebu's largest weekend food market offering a variety of local dishes, street food, and desserts.

Overnight stay at hotel in Cebu.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Visit Magellan's Cross and the historic Basilica del Santo Niño
- Experience Cebu's famous night food market at Sugbo Mercado

DAY 03: ENJOY KAWASAN CANYONEERING AND TRANSFER TO MOALBOAL

After breakfast at hotel, proceed for Kawasan canyoneering adventure and later enjoy the Moalboal sardine run.

Travel to South Cebu, known for its scenic waterfalls, limestone cliffs, and unique marine experiences. Begin with Kawasan Canyoneering, an adrenaline-filled activity that involves sliding through natural rock formations, jumping into



turquoise pools, and trekking along the canyon. Kawasan Falls is one of Cebu's most famous natural attractions, admired for its crystal-clear blue water and lush forest surroundings.











Later, proceed to Moalboal to witness the world-famous sardine run, where millions of sardines move in massive shimmering formations close to the shore. This natural phenomenon offers an unforgettable underwater experience.



Overnight stay at hotel in Moalboal.

- Experience thrilling canyoneering at Kawasan Falls
- Witness the magical Moalboal sardine run

DAY 04: EXPLORE PESCADOR ISLAND & RETURN TO CEBU

After breakfast at hotel, enjoy snorkelling at Pescador Island, visit Turtle Point, and relax at White Beach.

Start the day with a boat trip to Pescador Island, known for its rich coral gardens, underwater cliffs, and diverse marine life. The island is one of Cebu's best snorkelling spots, offering clear waters and vibrant reef ecosystems. Continue to Turtle Point, where green sea turtles can often be seen grazing peacefully on seagrass beds.













Later, proceed to White Beach in Moalboal, a serene stretch of sand ideal for swimming and relaxation.

Overnight stay at hotel in Cebu City.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Snorkel at Pescador Island and Turtle Point
- Relax at Moalboal's scenic White Beach

DAY 05: TRANSFER TO PANGLAO BEACH

After breakfast at hotel, take the ferry to Bohol and relax at Panglao Beach.

Bohol is known for its natural wonders, lush countryside, and pristine white-sand beaches. The island blends adventure with tranquillity, making it one of the Philippines' most popular destinations. Upon arrival, proceed to Panglao Beach, a beautiful coastline known for its crystal-clear waters, soft sand, and lively beachfront atmosphere.













Spend the remainder of the day enjoying the beach or exploring local cafés and seaside spots.

Overnight stay at hotel in Panglao.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Arrival in Bohol via scenic ferry ride
- Relax at the stunning Panglao Beach.

DAY 06: PANGLAO CITY TOUR

After breakfast at hotel, explore Chocolate Hills, visit the Tarsier Sanctuary, and enjoy the Loboc River Cruise and Man-Made Forest.

Begin with a visit to the Chocolate Hills, Bohol's iconic geological formation consisting of more than a thousand cone-shaped hills that turn brown during summer, giving them their "chocolate" appearance. Continue to the Tarsier Sanctuary to see the Philippine tarsier, one of the world's smallest primates known for its big round eyes and gentle nature.



Later, proceed for the Loboc River Cruise, a relaxing boat experience along emerald-green waters with local music onboard. Visit the Man-Made Forest, a dense, two-kilometre stretch of mahogany trees famous for its symmetry and scenic beauty













Overnight stay at hotel in Panglao.

HIGHLIGHTS

- See the world-famous Chocolate Hills
- Enjoy the serene Loboc River Cruise.

DAY 07: TRANSFER TO SIQUIJOR

After breakfast at hotel, take the ferry to Siquijor and visit Cambugahay Falls, Salagdoong Cliff Jump, and Paliton Beach.



Siquijor is known as the "Mystic Island," famous for its folklore, pristine waterfalls, and peaceful beaches. Begin with Cambugahay Falls, a three-tiered waterfall known for its clear blue pools and popular rope swings. Continue to Salagdoong Beach for cliff jumping into deep turquoise waters.

Later, proceed to Paliton Beach, known for its palm-lined shore and picturesque sunset views.

Overnight stay at hotel in Siquijo.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Swim in the turquoise pools of Cambugahay Falls
- Enjoy the sunset at scenic Paliton Beach.

DAY 08: TRANSFER TO CORON

After breakfast at hotel, enjoy a relaxed morning in Siquijor then transfer to fly into Coron.

Coron, located in Palawan, is renowned for its dramatic limestone cliffs, crystal-clear lagoons, and World War II shipwrecks resting underwater. The town is one of the top island-hopping destinations in the world, attracting travellers with its quiet charm and untouched beauty.













Spend the evening at leisure exploring Coron town or visiting its small cafés and shops.

Overnight stay at hotel in Coron.

SEGV RECOMMENDATION: Visit Maquinit Hot Springs for a natural saltwater hot bath experience.

- Arrival in Coron, one of Palawan's most scenic destinations
- Evening leisure in Coron town.

DAY 09: CORON ISLAND HOPPING

After breakfast at hotel, proceed for Coron Island Hopping covering Kayangan Lake, Twin Lagoon, Siete Pecados, and Barracuda Lake.

Begin with Kayangan Lake, often called the cleanest lake in the Philippines, known for its emerald waters and iconic viewpoint. Continue to Twin Lagoon, where two lagoons meet through a rock opening creating a unique mix of warm and cold water layers. Later, visit Siete Pecados Marine Park, a top snorkelling site known for its colourful corals and abundant fish species. End the day at Barracuda Lake, famous for its thermocline layers and dramatic limestone scenery.













Overnight stay at hotel in Coron.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Explore Kayangan Lake and the stunning Twin Lagoon
- Snorkel around Siete Pecados Marine Park.

DAY 10: TRANSFER TO EL NIDO – LAS CABAÑAS

After breakfast at hotel, proceed by fast ferry to El Nido, the gateway to the Bacuit Archipelago.

El Nido is one of the Philippines' most famous destinations, known for its majestic karst cliffs, turquoise lagoons, and island clusters. The town serves as a gateway to the Bacuit Archipelago, home to some of the country's most beautiful beaches. Spend the evening at Las Cabañas Beach, a serene coastline perfect for swimming, beach walks, and sunset views.

Overnight stay at hotel in El Nido.



HIGHLIGHTS

- Scenic ferry ride from Coron to El Nido
- Relaxing sunset at Las Cabañas Beach.











DAY 11: ENJOY THE EL NIDO -- TOUR A

After breakfast at hotel, proceed for El Nido Tour A covering Big Lagoon, Small Lagoon, Secret Lagoon, Shimizu Island, and 7 Commandos Beach.

Begin with Big Lagoon, known for its towering limestone formations and calm turquoise waters accessible through a narrow channel. Continue to Small Lagoon, a peaceful lagoon surrounded by cliffs ideal for kayaking. Visit Secret Lagoon, hidden behind limestone walls and reachable through a small opening. Later, proceed to Shimizu Island for snorkelling and relaxation. End the day at 7 Commandos Beach, a white-sand beach known for its clear waters and iconic palm trees.



Overnight stay at hotel in El Nido.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Kayaking inside Big Lagoon and Small Lagoon
- Enjoy the white sands of 7 Commandos Beach.

DAY 12: EXPLORE THE EL NIDO — TOUR C

After breakfast at hotel, proceed for El Nido Tour C covering Hidden Beach, Secret Beach, Matinloc Shrine, and Helicopter Island.











Start the tour at Hidden Beach, a scenic cove concealed by sharp limestone cliffs. Continue to Secret Beach, accessible by swimming through a small rock opening, surrounded by towering cliffs and turquoise waters. Visit Matinloc Shrine, a religious and historical site offering panoramic views of the sea. Later, proceed to Helicopter Island, named for its shape, known for its long stretch of sand and excellent snorkelling spots.



Overnight stay at hotel in El Nido.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Visit remote hidden beaches surrounded by limestone cliffs
- Snorkel at Helicopter Island.

DAY 13: TRANSFER TO BORACAY

After breakfast at hotel, fly to Boracay (via Manila/Cebu) and relax at White Beach.

Boracay is one of the Philippines' most celebrated tropical islands, known for its powder-soft white sand, vibrant nightlife, water activities, and calm turquoise waters. Upon arrival, proceed to White Beach, the island's main beach stretching over four kilometres and famous for its postcard-perfect beauty.



Spend the remainder of the day exploring the beachfront, cafés, and relaxing by the sea.









Overnight stay at hotel in Boracay.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Arrival at world-famous Boracay
- Relax at stunning White Beach.

DAY 14: DEPARTURE

After breakfast at hotel, enjoy Boracay Island hopping and sunset sailing before flying to Manila.



Proceed for island hopping covering spots like Crocodile Island and Crystal Cove, offering snorkelling opportunities and scenic ocean views. Enjoy a relaxing afternoon before proceeding for sunset sailing, one of Boracay's most iconic experiences offering uninterrupted views of the horizon.

Fly back to Manila for onward departure.
